

WSRC Spartan 300

The Spartan 300 is a challenging, 10 stage, all steel pistol and PCC match. The goal of the competitor is to achieve the 30 points for each stage and to attain all 300 points for the match as quickly as possible. Each stage will consist of 25 targets worth 1 point each and 1 bonus target worth 5 points. The targets will consist of reactive and static steel targets that will range in size and distance from 8 to 40 yards. Each stage will have its own par time depending on the complexity of the stage.

- Divisions for the match are based on USPSA, with a few modifications. Open, Limited, PCC, and CO are not changed. Production can load 15 rounds per magazine, and SS are allowed to have 10 round magazines. Major and minor power factors do not apply, but calibration zones on reactive targets will be calibrated for 9mm minor power factor.
- Competitors carrying their handgun in a holster must have an empty magazine well, and the hammer or striker must be de-cocked. Anyone found in violation of this rule will be immediately escorted by a Range Officer to a suitable safety area where appropriate corrective action shall be made. PCC must have a chamber flag or empty chamber indicator when not in ready condition.
- For PCC, each stage will require a minimum of 1 magazine reload. No side by side magazine couplers allowed. Magazines must be carried on the belt or in apparel pockets. No restriction on location on the belt. No thigh rigs or tie down magazine holders. End to end coupling/extension is allowed. PCC allowable calibers are 9mm, .357Sig, .40S&W, 10mm, and .45ACP.

- All external safeties must be engaged after shooter makes ready, and before the start signal.

Spartan 300 team rules

The 2019 Spartan 300 will expand the team competition.

- Teams will compete in 4 stages for their competition. Two match stages will be designated as team stages, as well as two team only stages.
- Each team will consist of 4 different team members. Only 3 members of each team will compete in each of the team stages, but a teammate cannot sit out more than once.
- 2 stages will be relay type stages, and 2 stages will be all 3 teammates on the firing line.
- Each team can consist of only 1 PCC and 1 Open division shooter. All other slots can be filled with any other division. PCC and Open are not required for teams.
- Individual scores plus team stage scores will be combined for the team overall score.
- An individual on a team that is shooting multiple registrations must shoot their team division run first for the match. No practice.
- Team entry is \$50.00. Winning team will earn team trophy. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be honored as well.

Mulligans

- Reshoots of stages will only be granted for stage malfunction, or RO interference.
 - Ammo, equipment, or shooter error will not constitute a reshoot of a stage.
 - A mulligan will be available to be purchased for a reshoot of a stage.
 - Shooters can only purchase 1 mulligan per entry.
 - Mulligans can be purchased before the match and during the match. Once the shooter tells the RO they want to use their mulligan, they cannot reverse their decision.
 - If the shooter finishes a stage and did not achieve the result they had hoped for, the shooter has until the stage is reset to decide if they want to “cash in” their mulligan for a reshoot.
 - Reshoots will take place after all squad members have shot the stage.
 - Mulligans will cost \$20.00 per entry (money goes to Friends of the World Shooting and Recreational complex)
